

Guide For Enrolment of CMAS Divers into a PADI Course

This guide can be used by PADI Instructors wishing to establish where a diver holding a current CMAS certification could begin training within the PADI System of Diver Education. It represents the highest level course that each diver could enrol in. At the PADI Instructor's discretion, based upon their preassessment of the diver, they may decide to begin training at lower levels within the PADI System.

It should be noted that the final decision to allow the use of a certification from other recreational training organisations as prerequisites for further training within PADI, is at the discretion of the individual PADI Instructor.

Please note that all other course prerequisites must be met prior to the start of training, eg. in date first aid and CPR.

One Star Diver (with at least 20 logged dives and experience in Deep and Navigation)	may enrol in a	Rescue Diver Course
Two Star Diver	may enrol in a	Divemaster Course
Three Star Diver	may enrol in an	Assistant Instructor Course or Instructor Development Course
One Star Instructor	may enrol in an	Instructor Development Course
Two Star Instructor	may enrol in an	Open Water Scuba Instructor Course
Three Star Instructor	may enrol in an	Open Water Scuba Instructor Course
